## Update on Harmonised Standards Lists

What's changed in the recent lists published in the OJEU

#### Frequently Asked Questions

Published by the EU it addresses questions like:

- What is the objective of the RE-D?
- Which equipment falls within the scope of RE-D?
- When does the RE-D start applying?
- What happens to the equipment which is already on the market but has not been sold to the end user yet?
- Will the EU withdraw radio equipment from the market because of the change of legislation from R&TTED to RE-D?
- What are harmonised standards for?
- Can manufacturers apply draft standards or other specifications that have not been published as harmonised standards?
- Is there any guidance on the application of the RE-D?
- Can manufacturers use harmonised standards of the R&TTE to demonstrate compliance with the RED?



## **UK Legislation**



#### The Radio Equipment Regulations 2017

The UK consultation on the draft UK regulations ran from 14 July 2017 to 14 August 2017, and sought views from stakeholders about 3 key areas of the proposed implementation:

- UK Draft Regulations to implement the Directive
- Enforcement of the UK Regulations
- The UK Impact Assessment on the Regulations

The feedback from this consultation is still being analysed.

## EMC Compliance in the USA

A basic introduction to the EMC legislation in the USA



#### **Code of Federal Regulations**

Electronic products operated or marketed in the USA must comply with the following legislation - unless specifically exempted.

<u>Title 47 (Telecommunication) Chapter I (Federal Communications Commission)</u> Subchapter A (General) Part 15 (Radio Frequency Devices),

Three common categories of product are:

- Mechanical product no electrical components
  - Out of scope
  - No action required
- 2. Electrical/Electronic product no radio function
  - Product is an "unintentional radiator"
  - There are allowed exemptions!! however, this legislation includes the following statement:
    - "Although not mandatory, it is strongly recommended that the manufacturer of an exempted device endeavor to have the device meet the specific technical standards in this part"

So some testing would be prudent to ensure products could comply

- Subpart B applicable, (often referred to as "FCC Part 15b")
- Testing at an FCC approved laboratory is not mandatory
- No FCC identification marking required on the product
- Electrical/Electronic product with radio function

  - Product is an "intentional radiator"
  - Subpart C applicable, (often referred to as "FCC Part 15c")
  - Testing required at an FCC approved laboratory, (unless an FCC approved radio module has been used)
  - FCC registration required (unless an FCC approved radio module has been used)
  - FCC identification marking required on the product (if an FCC approved radio module has been used this would be the module identification information)
